



Understanding Chronologies and Risk Assessment

Getting it Right for Every Child in Dundee – Practice development sessions

These workshops are designed to provide an opportunity for practitioners from multi –agency partners to learn together about using integrated chronologies and how these help inform risk assessment and effective children/young people’s plans. These are 3 hour workshops which allow participants to work together and draw from the range of their experience working with children and families.

Who is this learning opportunity for?

The practice development sessions are essential for all staff with Named Person functions as part of their role, or likely to have a Lead Professional role.

These include:

- Primary Head Teachers, relevant Deputy Principal Teachers and DCPOs
- Secondary Depute Head Teachers, and relevant Guidance/Support for Learning Teachers
- Health Visitors, Family Nurses, Midwives and Allied Health Professionals
- Social Workers (Children and Families Service)
- Relevant Third Sector Staff
- Other relevant practitioners identified in services

By attending the workshops you will Increase understanding and confidence:

- To develop and use chronologies with partners
- To apply risk assessment knowledge and tools to practice
- To share multi-agency responsibility for children and young people in Dundee
- To support effective children and young people’s plans
