



# Child Sexual Exploitation

## Who is this learning opportunity for?

This workshop is aimed at a broad range of professionals and volunteers working with adults and young people. These include; children and family workers, health visitors, teachers, youth workers and the voluntary sector.

## Learning outcomes

By undertaking this learning opportunity participants will have a better understanding of how children and young people become involved in Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE). The impact of their involvement and how practitioners can respond to protect and support children and young people affected by sexual exploitation.

By the end of the workshop participants will be able to:

- Explain key terminology and definitions in relation to CSE
- Identify and describe the key vulnerability factors, risk indicators and spectrum of experiences in relation to CSE
- Develop strategies to increase confidence in direct work with children and young people regarding CSE
- Recognise the importance of information sharing and multi-agency working in response to concerns
